- Abstract** – This collection contains research, teaching, administrative, and personal materials on Philippine history, culture, and society which Gregorio Zaide and his family (primarily Sonia Zaide, curator of the collection after Gregorio's death in 1986) collected, produced, or received over their careers as a historian, researcher, writer, educator, scholar, and public official in the Philippines. Primary focus is on Philippine history, culture, politics, resources, international relations, sociology, religion, customs, and traditions. Much of the material is in the form of newspaper clippings, handwritten notes, and drafts of papers for publication or presentation. Family correspondence, financial records, and travel folders illuminate their personal lives. Significant holdings include subject files on the Philippines covering all major events in the 20th century; people files on significant leaders and other interesting figures in Philippine history, including pre-history and the Spanish and American colonial eras; research notes from Zaide's many travels; draft and unpublished

articles and essays; personal and professional correspondence; and accompanying photographs. The bulk of the collection contains items assembled by Gregorio through his death in 1986, with later additions by family members from 1987-1996. These additions are located primarily in Series 1 (correspondence), Series 3 (family records), and Series 5 (subject files).

- Biographical Note –** Gregorio Fernandez Zaide was born May 25, 1907 in Pagsanjan, Laguna province, Philippines, the third of seven children of Francisco Duenas Zaide (1874-1931) and Carmen Fernandez (1876-1970). His early education was in Pagsanjan, and he graduated as valedictorian of this 1926 class at Laguna High School in nearby Santa Cruz. This entitled him to a free university education at the University of the Philippines (UP), and his academic career took off there, where he obtained B.A. (1929) and M.A. (1931) degrees in history. He began teaching at UP and later at San Beda College and the University of Santo Tomas (UST). While teaching at UST, Zaide earned

his Ph.D. in history (1934), and he joined the faculty of Far Eastern University (FEU), where he would teach for thirty years.

Also in 1934, Zaide married his UP college sweetheart, Dolores (“Lily”) Magbanua (1909-1989) of Pototan, Iloilo, Philippines. Their marriage produced three children who survived: Roberto, a surgeon (1936-), Gregorio Jr. (1938-1983), a pediatrician, and Sonia (1944-), also a historian, academic, and writer. Zaide was a talented writer; his first published work was a short story in 1925, beginning an era of historical essays which flourished in the nascent nationalism of the late colonial period press. His first published book, about the discovery of the Katipunan, came in 1931.

During the occupation in World War II the Japanese closed the schools and universities, so the Zaides fled Manila for Pagsanjan. With no professorships available, Gregorio worked in civil service and later operated a boat running produce from Laguna to Manila to survive. After the war, Zaide’s career took off as he became a well-known, highly prolific, and widely respected author of history textbooks in the Philippines. He authored some 62 published books and many more co-authored by Sonia Zaide. His history textbooks became the standard used in the 1950s-1970s in Philippine elementary and high schools as well as colleges and universities. He also authored over 500 articles.

Gregorio was frequently involved in civic duties and leadership roles. He was elected president of the Philippine Historical Association for an unprecedented three terms in the 1960s-1970s. While enjoying a productive semi-retirement in Pagsanjan, writing and revising his earlier textbooks, he served as founding president of the Pagsanjan Rotary from 1973-1974 and won a term as Pagsanjan mayor in

1971, presiding over the restoration of local historic monuments for the town's tricentennial celebration.

A stroke in 1981 and other health complications limited Gregorio's writings, travels, and public appearances in his later years. Gregorio died October 31, 1986 from cardiorespiratory failure at Singian Memorial Hospital in Manila. He is interred in Pagsanjan Cemetery, Laguna, Philippines.

A more complete description of the life and work of Gregorio Zaide can be found in The Historical Heritage of Gregorio F. Zaide, a 1989 paper by Sonia Zaide, located in Series 3, Subseries 1, Folder 3.

Scope and Contents –

The collection consists of approximately 30 cubic feet of research, teaching, administrative, and personal materials relating to Gregorio Zaide's work as a historian, writer, academic, and public official in the Philippines from the 1930s up to his death in 1986. After his death, the collection was maintained by his wife Dolores until her death in 1989, and then by daughter Sonia until current custodianship was assumed through purchase by the Ortigas Foundation Library in 1996. Significant rearrangement and additions were made by Zaide's heirs; additions can usually be determined by date and penmanship of accompanying notes, while rearrangement is trickier to decipher. It is clear that Zaide maintained separate filing arrangements for subjects, persons, correspondence, travel, and family records. Although new subjects were clearly added after Zaide's death, the present arrangement closely reflects Zaide's original schema.

The present papers and collection includes research notes and materials, draft and published manuscripts, articles and clippings, awards and recognitions, correspondence, family records, photographs, and ephemeral materials. The bulk of the materials consist of Zaide's carefully maintained subject and persons files which were used as research materials. There is a significant collection of personal and professional correspondence as noted below, travel and conference materials, and administrative records relating to his term as mayor of Pagsanjan from 1971-1975. Materials are arranged into seven series, as follows:

Series 1: Correspondence, 1940-1996. Series contains personal letters and greeting cards with enclosures from the Zaide family, including children and grandchildren (primarily from Gregorio, Dolores, Gregorio Jr., and Sonia) and professional correspondence (the latter primarily involving Gregorio). Materials are arranged by type (family or professional) into 2 subseries, as follows:

Subseries 1: Zaide family correspondence, 1945-1996 (bulk 1960-1980).

Letters, notes, and cable transmissions between and among Gregorio and Dolores Zaide, their children, grandchildren, and extended family.

Arranged chronologically into 10 folders.

Subseries 2: Gregorio Zaide professional correspondence, 1940-1986.

Letters and notes of an official or professional nature to, from, or pertaining to Gregorio Zaide. Arranged chronologically into 2 folders.

Series 2: Photographs and Negatives, 1957, 1958, 1962, 1964, 1967, 1970, 1980, and undated. Series consists of black and white and color photographic prints and negatives. Arranged chronologically (where feasible) into 1 folder. *See "special note on photographs" in the Notes section below for additional locations of photographic materials.*

Series 3: Zaide Family Records, 1934-1996. Series contains awards and honors, notices and press clippings related to family achievements, financial records (including a detailed, annotated general ledger), vital records (birth, death, and marriage certificates), cards and mementos, and later records pertaining to Sonia Zaide's activities after her parents' deaths. Arranged by type of record into 4 subseries, as follows:

Subseries 1: Awards and recognitions, 1960-1984. Materials and notices regarding Gregorio and his children's awards, honors, recognitions, and accomplishments. Arranged chronologically by recipient into 5 folders.

Subseries 2: Cards and mementos, 1934-1995. Greeting cards, condolences, newspaper clippings, photographs, notes, announcements, and ephemera pertaining to the Zaide family. Arranged chronologically into 2 folders.

Subseries 3: Financial records, 1945-1996. Receipts, tax records, financial statements, tenancy contracts, purchase/sale/transfers of assets, and legal notices pertaining thereto. Arranged chronologically into 5 folders.

Subseries 4: Vital records, 1934-1993. Birth, death, marriage, divorce, school records, wills, and estate documents. Arranged by person, and then chronologically, into 4 folders.

Series 4: Travel records, 1959-1976 and undated. Series contains itineraries, tickets, travel documents, notes, postcards, photographs, souvenirs, ephemera, and other mementoes from Gregorio Zaide's travels abroad. Materials are arranged chronologically into 12 folders.

Series 5: Subject Files, 1919-1996 and undated (bulk 1946-1986). Series contains articles, clippings, conference and scholarly papers, brochures, pamphlets, meeting minutes, bibliographies, photographs, legal papers, and records pertaining to a wide variety of Philippine and world events, history, conflicts, locations, organizations, political entities, cultural activities and other topics of personal or professional interest to Gregorio and Sonia Zaide. Series is arranged alphabetically by subject name into 276 folders. Arranged chronologically within folders, except as noted below.

Series 6: Persons Files, 1926-1995 and undated (bulk 1946-1977). Series contains articles, clippings, notes, speeches, commemorations and pamphlets relating to Filipino and non-Filipino figures involved in the history, culture, and development of the Philippines. Series is arranged alphabetically by person's last name into 239 folders. Arranged chronologically within folders.

Series 7: Catalog of the Zaide Library, undated. Series contains photocopies of catalog entries of the holdings of Gregorio Zaide's personal library. Arranged chronologically by era of book's publication into 7 folders. Within folders, entries are arranged alphabetically by author's last name.

Related Material – None known.

Separated Material – Published and unpublished books, manuscripts, pamphlets, and magazines from the Zaide library are cataloged separately and held in the Ortigas Foundation Library collection.

Notes – - Many written materials have been subjected to water and insect damage which affects their readability. Paper in many cases is degraded, discolored, stained, torn, and brittle, which necessitates special handling precautions; see staff for details and assistance. Photographs and negatives are in various states of preservation primarily due to

water damage, and a portion may be so degraded as to be unviewable.

- As noted above, materials have been added after Gregorio's death, and the collection shows evidence of rearrangement by Zaide's heirs; researchers are directed to dates of items and handwriting for clues as to provenance and context of materials dated 1986 and later.

- Special note on photographs: Gregorio Zaide did not maintain photographic records separately, except in Series 2, Folder 1. Zaide's original order has been maintained to provide a richer and fuller context to the materials. Therefore, photographs may be found in Series 2 – Photographs but also in Series 3 – Family Records, Series 4 – Travel Records, and Series 5 – Subject Files.
